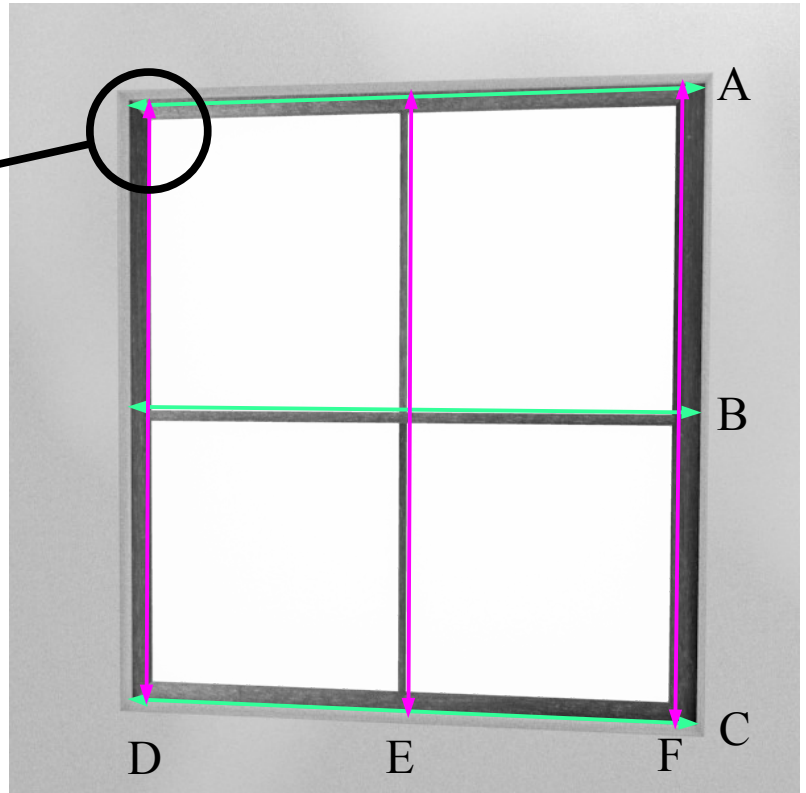
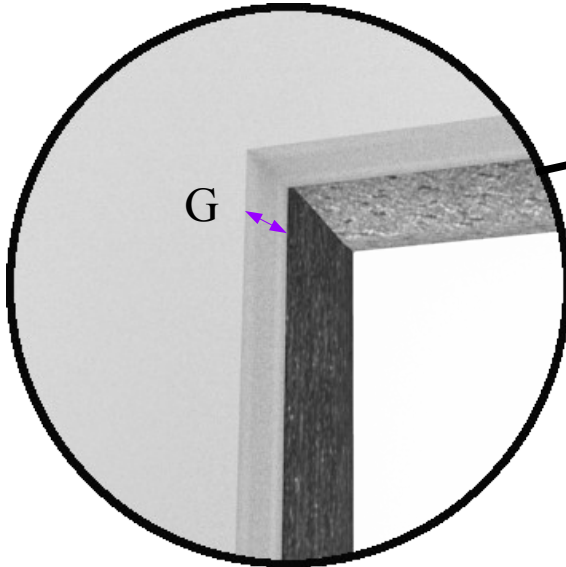






Rectangular window insert worksheet



A: Top Width	
B: Middle Width	
C: Bottom Width	
D: Left Height

F: Right Height

Measurements A-F: There are sometimes slight variations in a window's dimensions. allow us to create a frame template that will fit your individual window better than a perfect rectangle would.

Measurement G: This is where your insert will actually install: Against the wall, or the first perpendicular frame that gives us at least 1/2" of flat space to mount into.

*** Single / Double sided:** Faux Iron grilles can be created with beveling on the front only, or the front and back, as you see in the illustrations at the bottom of the page. Double-Sided beveling does cost a little bit more, so if your window will not be seen much from the back, then you should consider ordering single-sided bevels.

Unless otherwise noted, the manufacturer will take a small (1/8") deduction from the measurements listed on this approval form, for installation. If you do not want this deduction to be taken, please inform our order coordinator, and we will issue you a properly noted form.
